



Water Activity Centre (WAC) Waiver

The WAC aims to encourage nippers, from the U9s age group and above, out into the water and grow their confidence in the surf. The WAC will be used at Nippers when Water Safety Managers and Patrol Captains have agreed that surf conditions are appropriate for its use. Whilst the younger age groups (U6s/U7s/U8s) are not able to use the equipment when located in the water, in line with SLSA guidelines, they will be able to participate when it is set up on the beach.

Use of the WAC will be managed under a structured protocol.

It is important for parents to recognise that the WAC is a potentially dangerous recreational activity and the club will not be held liable for injury or loss, however caused, resulting from use of the WAC.

Newport Surf Club has issued the risk warning under Section 5m of the Civil Liability Act 2002.

If you would like your child to access the WAC, please sign and date below, and give it to your Age manager. **No child will be allowed to use the WAC, wether in the water or on the sand, unless this waiver has been completed.**
