- This came out of the recent Coronial enquiry
- To be used during briefing, PCs to take photos throughout the day as proof of due diligence
- Instead of buying a whiteboard on a stand, Jess is intending to use hooks to hang off the patrol barrier
- PCs don't have to use it
- Rebecca Capell: Nippers are thinking of using it so age groups can be tracked
- This might also help keep younger members more engaged
